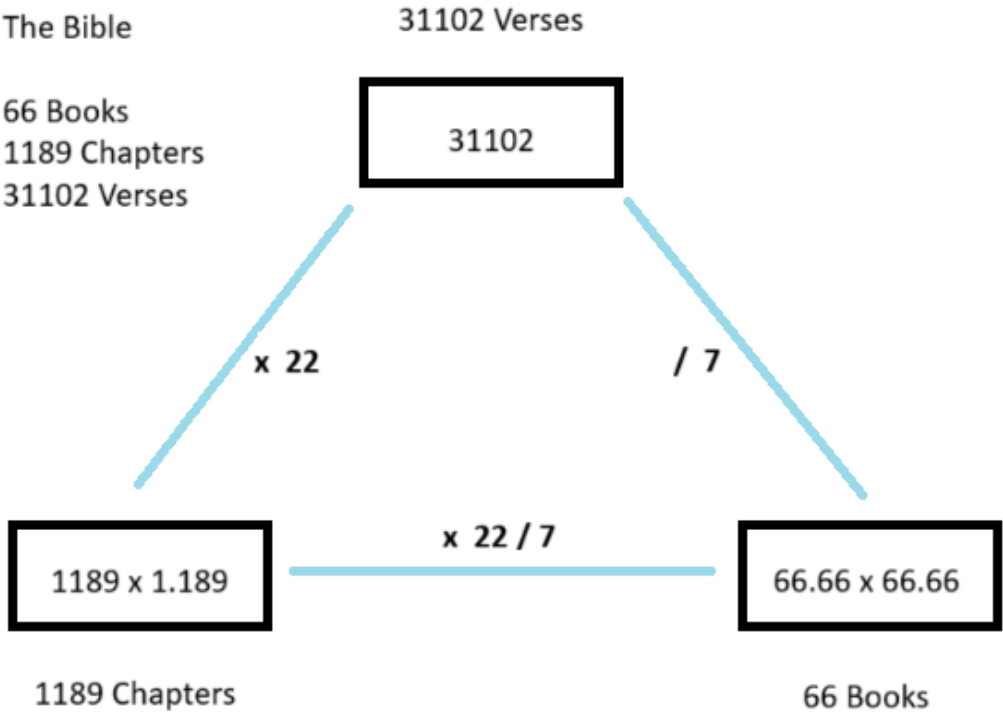
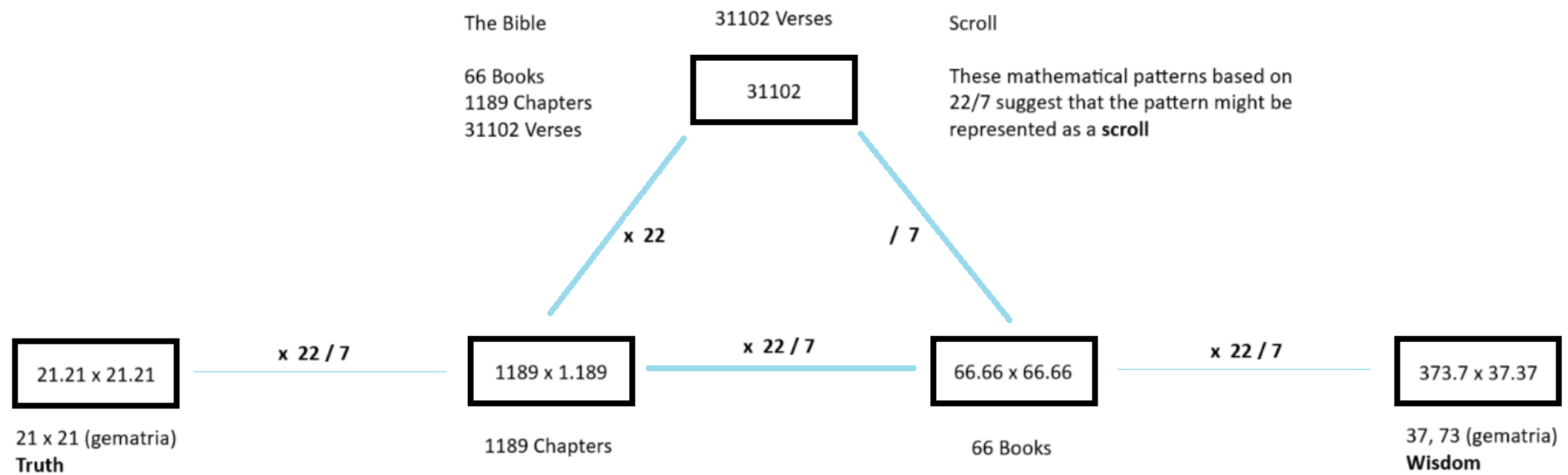
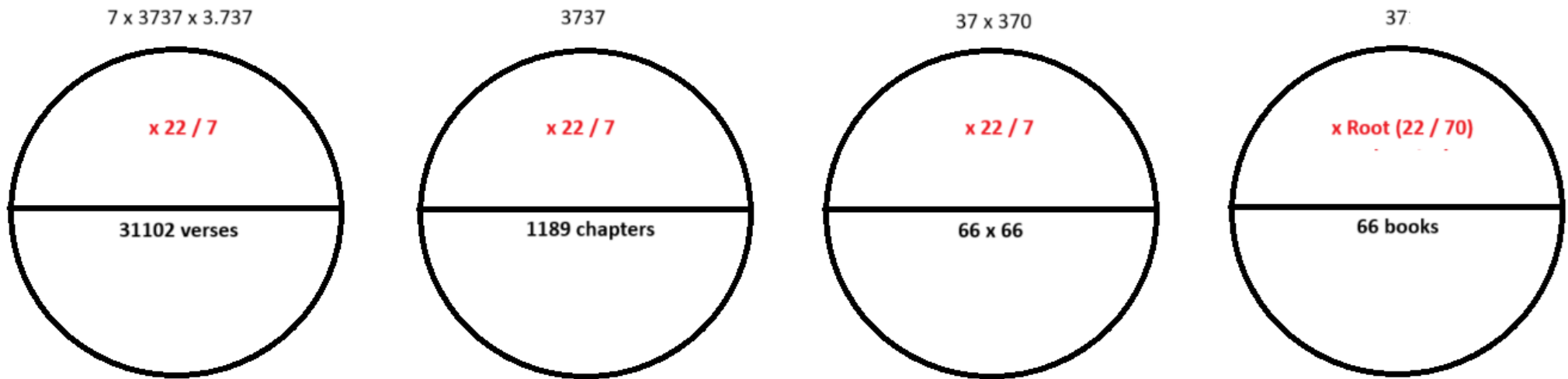


Patterns of Wisdom and Light

Verses per chapter 6.9997×3.737

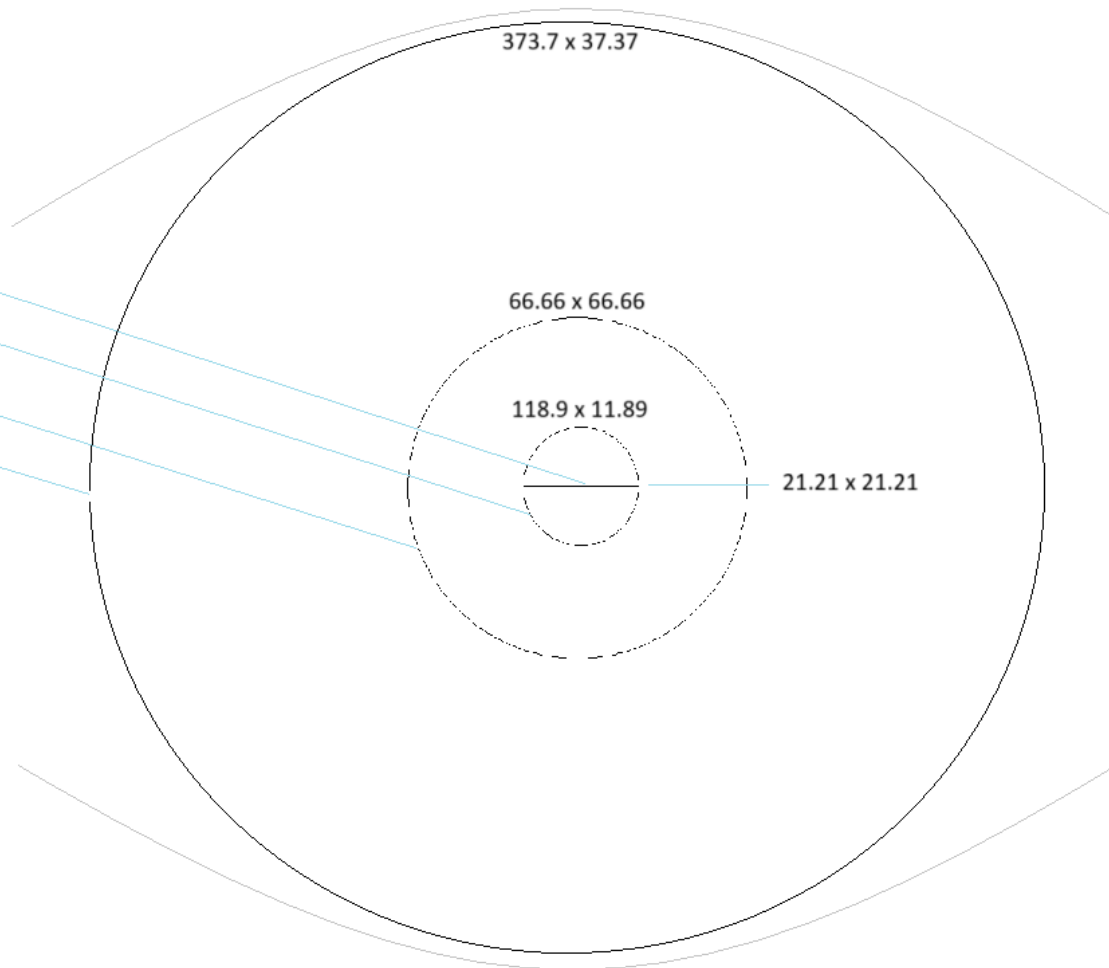
So you can see that the number of verses, chapters and books are all related to the number for wisdom (37) by pi ! This suggests that they are all a manifestation of that wisdom. A perfect divine wisdom can be symbolized by a circle - in two dimensional space. This wisdom manifests to humans as a diameter, a line - in one dimension space.

This suggests that the Bible is a certain kind of wisdom given from God to us. It may not be in a form we expect, but rather was chosen for us. It also suggests that what is infinite and perfect manifests with reduced dimensionality to us – in our “flat-land”. We may have to search, contemplate or apply it in order to gain an understanding.

Each circle expands by 22/7 from the previous circle.

Truth
Chapters
Books
Wisdom

But each circle also represents the entirety.



Each circle is also a square. The squared-circle is a symbol of the union of infinite and finite, of heaven and earth.

The image resembles an eye because truth and wisdom are light.

Truth is important to God

“If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eyes are unhealthy, your whole body will be full of darkness. If then the light within you is darkness, how great is that darkness!”



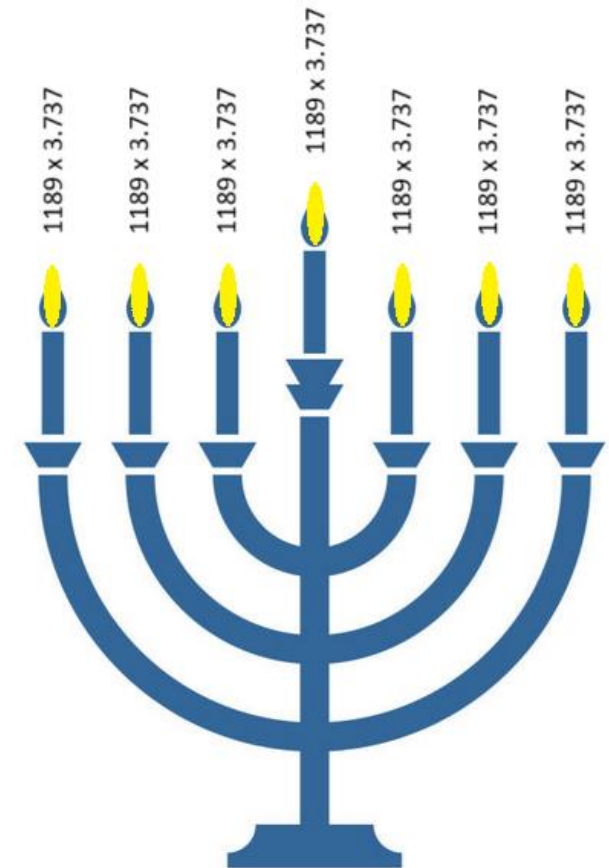

So, there are $7 \times (66.66 + 0.6666)$ verses per book on average.

Light can be split into 7 colours.

The total number of verses (31102) splits into 7 parts each of 66.66×66.66

The total number of verses (31102) splits into 7 parts each of 1189×3.737

So, there are 7×3.737 verses per chapter on average.

The Bible is not what it seems - it is more than a random collection of ancient literature. It is structured to embody a certain kind of wisdom, knowledge, understanding and truth. That knowledge is conveyed through an alphabet.

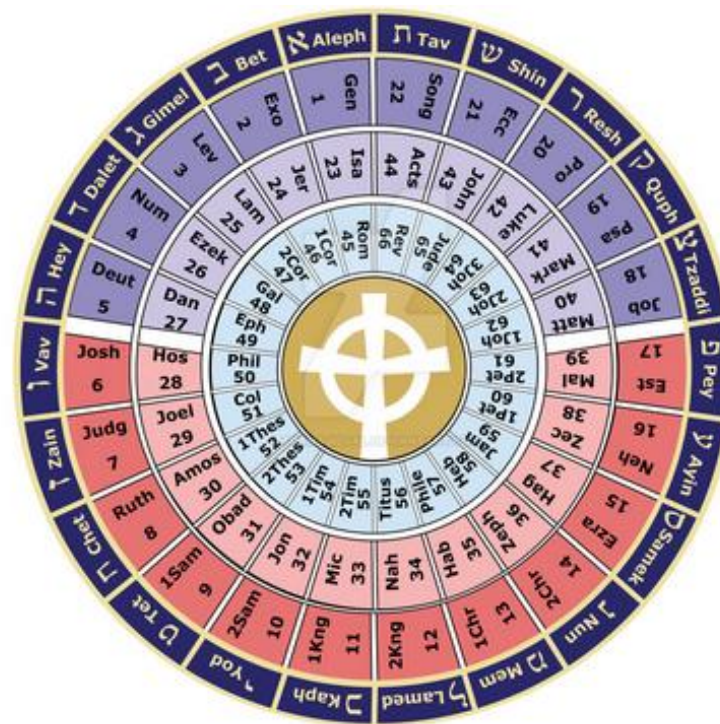
The proverbs of Solomon son of David, king of Israel:

- ²for gaining **wisdom** and instruction;
for **understanding** words of insight;
- ³for receiving **instruction** in prudent behaviour,
doing what is right and just and fair;
- ⁴for giving **prudence** to those who are simple,^[a]
knowledge and discretion to the young—
- ⁵let the wise listen and add to their learning,
and let the discerning get guidance—
- ⁶for understanding proverbs and parables,
the sayings and riddles of the wise.^[b]
- ⁷The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge,
but fools^[c] despise wisdom and instruction.

3 cycles of 22 books each corresponding to the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet,
falling into 7 categories.

22 alphabet spokes averaging 1189 x 1.189 verses each

1189 chapters averaging 22 x 1.189 verses each



CONTEXT : REFORMATION

Printed word was introduced at this time, which made the scriptures affordable to all. Before this, the scriptures were hand written and extremely expensive – so only the very rich could afford them.		
Chapter and verse divisions were also introduced at this time into all bibles (both Catholic and Protestant) . These divisions enabled people to study the Bible and reference it – boosting educational access to it.

The great divide between Catholics and Protestants was that Protestants looked to God alone, whereas Catholics looked to God + Man.

TRUTH vs AUTHORITY

1. Protestants looked to SCRIPTURE alone, whilst Catholics also looked to TRADITIONS
2. Protestants adopted the common core of universally accepted Scripture – the proto-canon, whilst Catholics added controversial Scriptures as well – the deuterocanon.
3. Protestants sought TRUTH, whilst Catholics also sought AUTHORITY
4. Protestants wanted the Scriptures in a COMMON LANGUAGE, accessible to all, whilst Catholics wanted the Scriptures to remain in an ELITE LANGUAGE (Latin), only accessible to priests.

It is remarkable that -

1. the PRINTED WORD began at this time, enabling the Scriptures to be copied cheaply, and so making them affordable to everyone. Before this, Scripture was copied by hand which was extremely expensive, and only the very rich could afford a copy. It also took years to make each copy.
2. Chapter and verse divisions were introduced in Bibles at this time that enabled the study and referencing of the Bible.
3. Further, this coincided with the translation into the common tongue

Seems like providence.

SALVATION

1. Protestants looked to FAITH alone, whilst Catholics looked to Faith and WORKS.
2. Protestants sought direct salvation, whilst Catholics sought salvation through priestly intermediaries.
3. Protestants sought forgiveness through prayer, whilst Catholics provided salvation through confession to a priest, penances and indulgences paid to the Church.

LIFE-STYLE

1. Protestants sought an honest and righteous lifestyle, whilst the Catholic church sought wealth, power
2. Protestants adopted the Scriptures of the moralistic Hebrews, whilst Catholics adopted the Scriptures of the worldly and syncretistic Greeks.

METAPHYSICS

1. Protestants were “heavenly-minded”, whilst Catholics were “earthly-minded”
2. For Protestants the sun was the center and we orbited it, whilst for Catholics the earth was the center – aka Galileo.

The Catholic system was therefore more influenced/ corrupted by human books, human authorities, human effort, pride and greed. In contrast, the Protestant system relied solely on divine books, God’s authority alone, faith alone, humility.

A SCHISM SINCE THE BEGINNING

This great divide is present at the beginning of the Bible where God creates heaven and earth as 666 and 703.

- “In the beginning God created the Heavens” has gematria 666 + 666 + 666
- “and the earth” has gematria 703

We find this dichotomy in the number of books –

- Protestant : 66
- Catholic : 73

It is almost as if the Bible foresees this schism back in Genesis. The story of Cain and Abel is where Cain provides the fruit of his labor, whilst Abel relies in faith upon the sacrifice of an animal. Cain is enraged that his work is not accepted, whilst that of Abel is.

GODS STAMP OF APPROVAL

God bears witness to the purity and authority of the Scriptures, over and above any man-made traditions, laws or governing bodies (such as any church or state) –

Isaiah is a microcosm of the whole Bible, and the gospel of Isaiah reflects the gospel of Christ. Isa Yah means “Jesus is God”.

Books, chapters and verses are all related to 37 by 22/7. In other words, they are all a manifestation of God’s wisdom.

THE UNIVERSAL CORE

Proto-canon :

consists of those books held in common by all factions of Christianity – both Catholic, Protestant and Eastern Orthodox. The proto-canon was also the Old Testament books held in common between the Masoretic Text and the Septuagint.

Deutero-canon :

consists of those books which differ from one faction to another.

CONTEXT : RENAISSANCE

The odd thing is that the Protestants broke away from the Catholics because the Protestants upheld the authority of Scripture over and above the Church, whilst the Catholics maintained that Scripture could be overridden by papal edicts or by spurious traditions.

It is curious because the chapter and verse divisions that were introduced into all bibles at this time (both Catholic and Protestant) show that the divisions of the Protestant Bible - its chapters verses and books - are mathematically related to wisdom and truth by pi. Hence it is as if God were placing His seal upon their Scripture as to its truth and its precedence over all human authority .

Strangely, the use of pi as a means of validation echoes in the work of Galileo who at that time demonstrated that the earth goes around the Sun . The Sun being a symbol of God. The Catholic Church held to the opposite and persecuted Galileo accordingly.

Similarly at this time Leonardo da Vinci conceived the Vitruvius Man - portraying him within a squared circle. As I have shown above, in the divisions of the Bible, the chapters , books and wisdom itself form ascending circles each expanding by pi, and each circle also has a circumference that is a “square” – viz

1189 x 1.189

66.66 x 66.66

373.7 x 37.37

It was if a new age was beginning - and God had set His seal upon it – an age of light and truth.
